

- **Aranui Clinic, 240 Breezes Road, Aranui,**

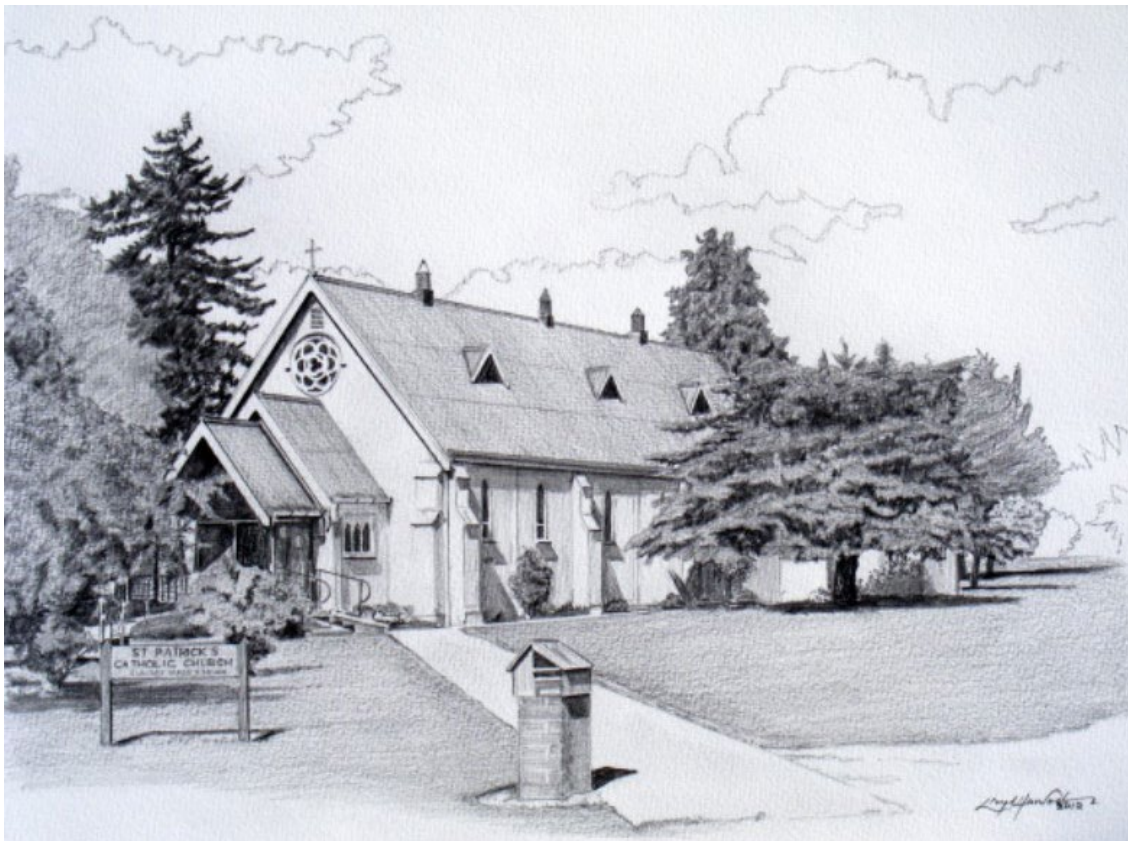
**Burnside Clinic, 96A Memorial Avenue, Burnside,**

### FAITH FACTS

The next part of the Mass is called the Liturgy of the Word. In the Liturgy of the Word we celebrate Christ's presence in the Scripture. We need to listen carefully to the three readings and the Psalm. The Liturgy of the Word begins with the First Reading, which is taken from the Old Testament, except during the Easter Season, when the Acts of the Apostles are read. We respond to this reading by either singing or saying the Responsorial Psalm.
